Orissa Follow-Up is Community based Organization and registered under societies registration act. As an association it started in the year 1982 but officially it was registered under Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 in the year 9th of April 1986.

In the inception as a very small organization doing the social work by way of community participation at the grass-root level, literature publication, Community Health Educations, poverty alleviation program, Youth Development and Vocational education, Non Formal Education and Disaster Management. Orissa Follow-Up was founded by Dr. D.B. Hrudaya in the year 1982 with a handful of 4 dedicated rural young person's to serve the Communities in the state of Odisha with the aim to bring transformation in the downtrodden and most deprived vulnerable communities.
